



METHAMPHETAMINE LABORATORY CLEANUP

ASSESSMENT

- Law enforcement discovers property with evidence of methamphetamine or laboratory
- County Task Force performs field test for presence of residue
- County Task Force submits results of field test to Festus Code Enforcement
- Festus Code Enforcement post structure unsafe
- Unsafe structures must be vacated and unoccupied until Code Official orders that status removed

DECONTAMINATION

- Property owner must establish plan/schedule with Festus Code Enforcement to decontaminate or retest within 48 hours of posting

Decontamination must be performed by a qualified contractor

A qualified contractor at minimum must have:

- Completed 40 hours of Hazardous Waste Operations & Emergency Response training (HAZWOPER)
- OSHA 29 CFR 1910
- Clandestine Drug Lab Assessment & Decontamination Course

POST-DECONTAMINATION SAMPLING

- Post-remediation testing by Festus Code Enforcement approved company
- City inspector to be present for post-remediation testing (\$35.00 occupancy fee)
- Property owner to provide testing and results
